MCN Requirements for Scholarship Funding

The scholarship has been established at the Manchester Church of the Nazarene to assist Christian young people in furthering their education. The scholarship opportunity may be granted to those who meet the following requirements:

1. The candidate must be a graduate of The Cornerstone Christian School and/or a member of or regularly attends the Manchester Church of the Nazarene (MCN).
2. The student has applied, been accepted and received their official award letter from Eastern Nazarene College (ENC), which outlines all institutional aid, as well as federal aid from the FASFA.
3. The student must be in/applying for the full-time undergraduate program. Full-time is defined as at least 12 credit hours per semester.

The application is good for the 2023-24 school year, but the scholarships awarded are anticipated to be four-year scholarships. Generally, the scholarship will be automatically renewed if the student is in good standing with the college and maintains a GPA of 3.0 or better. If these conditions are not met, another application will be necessary for a determination of whether or not the student will receive a scholarship. Specifics will be spelled out in the award letter and may not be the same for every award recipient.

This application, along with the official award letter from ENC, must be submitted through the church office for consideration by the MCN ENC Scholarship Committee. Completion of this application does not guarantee a scholarship award. All recommendations of the Scholarship Committee must be approved by the Church Board.

Application Process:

1. Applications will be accepted at the MCN Church Office beginning in January for the Fall 2023 Semester.
2. After reviewing complete applications, the committee will schedule an interview with the student.
3. Award decisions will typically take 4-6 weeks after receiving a complete application.

In submitting this application, you are also agreeing to give the MCN Scholarship Committee and Eastern Nazarene College permission to share all information submitted to the church and the college, to verify your high school record with your guidance counselor, and to discuss your financial awards.

The decision of the Scholarship Committee and Church Board are final.
